DAY 1 - Monday, 28th April, 2025

Sub-Theme 1: Globalization of Legal Education in the Digital Age

Keynote Speaker: Prof. (Dr.) Ritu Gupta, NLU Delhi

The globalization of legal education in the digital age involves integrating technology to enhance learning, promote international collaboration, and prepare students for a globalized profession, while also addressing challenges like digital access and the potential dehumanization in the field.

DAY 2 - Tuesday, 29th April, 2025

Sub-Theme 2: Role of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Automation in Legal Education

Keynote Speaker: Prof. (Dr.) Vandana, USLLS, GGSIP University

Artificial Intelligence is being integrated into the profession to prepare the professionals, academicians and students for the evolving legal landscape. The modules have been structured to offer a larger spectrum of practice covering AI applications in law, ethical considerations, legal research, automated legal assistance, predictive analytics, contract management and the like.

The evident changes in the ownership paradigms are being witnessed, which is in consequence pushing the IP professionals to adapt and evolve their legal strategies so as to ensure creators and innovators receive the protection they deserve which shall be covered by the sub-theme in detail.
