Then he requested 1<sup>st</sup> panelist Mr Michael Rada to share his thoughts on the topic. Mr Rada explained that INDUSTRY 5.0 is not the fifth industrial revolution. It was launched as the first industrial evolution ever led by man (human) and it is based on the principles of systematic waste prevention recognizing and preventing mainly on four types of waste physical, social, urban and process waste. He continued that if 6R's of sustainability is then we can reach wasteful to wasteless.

Panel session was followed by 2<sup>nd</sup> keynote speaker Prof. (Dr.) K. S. Gupta, he highlighted about the digital transformation and business practices in Industry 5.0. He suggested teachers to become facilitators then only they will be able to transform students into learners.

Next in sequence, Prof. (Dr.) G.B.Sitaram, 3rd session panelist emphasized on rural connectivity and sustainable rural development. He stated examples of various Indian districts, coming with various skill development programmes and digital literacy Workshops.

They also acted as judges for the session and assigned marks to each presenter through the Google excel sheet already shared with them.



*Summary Report of One Week (Online) Faculty Development Programme*

The Ideal Institute of Management and Technology, Delhi has organised the One-Week Faculty Development Programme on the theme “International Interdisciplinary Sustainable Strategies and Reflections in Law, Management and Information Technology in the Digital Era” from 24<sup>th</sup> July – 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 in collaboration with Mahatama Hansraj Faculty Development Centre of Hansraj College, University of Delhi. (A Centre of Ministry of Education, Government of India, under Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching)

The programme was designed as a structured training programme targeted at members of the faculties of Law, Management and Information Technology across the nation. The programme has been conducted to promote facilitation of new and novel trends in sustainable practices and reflections in the digital era. The inter-disciplinary approach of the FDP helped the organizers in inviting key academicians from all the three focal areas. The One week Programme was very meticulously divided into 2 sessions each day – the first session from 1 pm to 2.30 pm and the second

session from 2.45 pm to 4.30 pm. Each session started with welcome of the participants by the anchor , followed by the Welcome Address and felicitation of the keynote speaker. After the presentation , the Speaker answered to the queries raised by participants .Each Session ended with the Vote of Thanks and the Patriotic Song.

The Faculty Development Programme started on 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 at 1.00 pm with Saraswati Vandana, followed by a small Inaugural Address by the **Chief Guest, Prof.(Dr.) Anil Parkash Sharma**. The Inauguration of the FDP was followed by the first session by the eminent speaker, Prof.(Dr.) Anil Parkash Sharma, Director, Ideal Institute of Management & Technology. Prof. Sharma chose the topic '**Sustainable Development in Organization Through Personal Branding**' for the opening session of the FDP. The speaker started his discussion with some practical examples to make the meaning of Personal Branding clear . He discussed the importance of Personal Branding and its relationship with Sustainable Development in organizations by connecting it to the organization's sustainability practices, that helps in building trust and credibility for the employees and also makes the employees more confident and competent. Building a Personal Brand that aligns with sustainable values and strategies of the organisation helps in creating a compelling personal brand statement .He stressed upon the importance of Communication as a vital tool for the sustainability in personal branding. He presented some actionable steps and tools for employees and leaders to integrate personal branding with sustainable efforts of the organization..

**The second session of the first day was taken by Prof. (Dr.) Komal Vig, Dean, Sharda University, She shared her views on the topic . "Legal Aspect : Sustainable Development In The Era Of Digitalization"** . She initiated her address by explaining the concept of sustainable development along with the parameters of determining urgent needs of humanity, awareness of the limited natural resources and the objective impossibility of the environment to satisfy the ever increasing demands of humanity. She laid emphasis on legal recognition of sustainable development with respect to the philosophy of consumption.

She shared her views on how the laws can play a crucial role in implementing and achieving sustainable development goals and gave several examples related to Land use and planning laws, Laws related to Climate change, corporate

Sustainability Reporting, Renewable Energy Standards, Sustainable Agriculture and Food Safety, Water management laws, Indigenous Rights and Environmental Justice, Waste Management Regulations and several other Laws and regulations that provide the framework for defining, promoting and enforcing sustainable practices across various sectors of society. She also briefly touched upon the laws related to Cybersecurity, Data privacy, Intellectual Property rights, E commerce & Consumer protection, Digital Identity and Net Neutrality .

**The second day of FDP , 25<sup>th</sup> July , 2023, started with the session by Prof. (Dr.) Achal Kaushik, Professor and Head (CSE), Bhagwan Parshuram Institute of Technology.** He shared his views on the topic, “ Role of Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Augmented Reality (AR), Virtual Reality (VR) in Intelligent and Sustainable Manufacturing”. The session was started by extensively explaining the different stages of Industrial Revolution and the transformation from mechanical to electrical to internet to digital (the current stage) to make the gathering understand the multi-fold effect that it has brought in the present day environment. He apprised the audience about the concept of ‘Intelligent and Sustainable Manufacturing’, and the way the same can be achieved by the amalgamation of advanced technologies and systems to enable smarter operations. Prof. Kaushik prominently brought forth the ‘Blockchain Technology’ to be a perfect example of the way advancement has fostered the space encompassing transparency and traceability. He discussed about the positive role of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in using advanced analytics to identify patterns, optimize processes, and make data-driven decisions for better allocation and improved efficiency and quality .He gave the example of the use of Autonomous Guided Vehicles (AGVs) used in manufacturing and warehousing for material handling, being used to enhance the overall logistics. He explained in detail the changes brought by Virtual Reality (VR), Augmented Reality (AR), Mixed Reality (MR), and Extended Reality (XR) in the manufacturing process and how this has brought several benefits, such as faster on-boarding and reduced errors on the production floor. He also discussed the various issues and challenges brought forth by the recent trends . He specifically highlighted the requirement of research in the area of human-robot collaboration, and implementation of smart factory layouts.

The second session on Day 2 of FDP was taken by Prof. Monika Aggarwal, Professor, University Institute of Applied Sciences, Panjab University, Chandigarh. She deliberated on the Topic: Application of Bibliometric Methods in Management. The hon'ble speaker commenced by extensively explaining the importance of systematic 'Literature Review', and how if done properly it can contribute towards high quality of research. Professor further appraised the gathering about the way statistical analysis of bibliographic data commonly focuses on citation analysis of research output and publications which essentially aid in giving quantitative analysis of academic literature. Prof. Aggarwal extensively discussed the appropriate manner of searching on 'Scopus', and while doing so gave extensive insights, such as the importance of using appropriate quotation marks, and keywords. Thereafter, the speaker took the gathering on a virtual demonstration for advanced study of the process of searching. The interactive hands-on-training comprised of showcasing and discussing the document results in case of general as well as advanced queries. She also delivered a hands-on-training on VOSviewer Software. The mode used aided in better understanding of the collaborative efforts that can be made because of the data retrieved by using network, overlay and density visualisation, and the simultaneous practice of the usage surely enhanced the learning experience.

**The third day of the FDP on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 started with the session by Prof. Rajesh Kumar Tiwari, Principal, RVS College of Engineering And Technology, Jharkhand who shared his views on the topic "Big Data Analytics" .** Prof. Tiwari initiated his session by emphasizing on the importance of Data Analytics in present world. He explained the concept of Data, types of Data like Relational Data, Text Data, Graph Data, etc. by quoting the real life examples, how data can be processed by using statistical tools to get the information which can finally produce knowledge. He further shared sources of data collection and challenges in extracting data due to its volume, variety and complexities. He also summarized SQL Vs NoSQL skill for Data science and popular structured and unstructured Databases. The collected data needs to be cut, pruned, and filtered so that merged data from multiple sources can be loaded into dimensional modeled tables.

He concluded his discussion by stressing on the usefulness of big data not only in the field of IT and Management but also in Law, as legal data is huge and thus needs to be simplified which can be done by making use of Data Analytics.

The second session of the day was taken by Prof. (Dr.) Seema Yadav, Professor, Galgotia University, Greater Noida who presented her insights on the Topic: “ Aligning Corporate Laws with sustainable Development Goals ” She initiated her session with explaining the concept of Sustainable Development, which focuses on economic development without compromising the quality of environment for future generations. She elaborated in detail about the 17 SDG’s laid down by the United Nations 169 specific targets to be achieved by 2030. She also discussed about the legislations related to SDG’s, including the concept of Corporate Social responsibility, which has been positioned in Schedule VII of Companies Act, 2013. She further discussed the concept of Corporate Governance which includes 3 important P’s ; People, Planet and Profit. BRR , BSRS based on ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance)is mandatory for companies for sustainable Development. She concluded her discussion by drawing the attention of the audience on the challenges in achieving SDG’s like Limited Availability of NGO’s in India, lack of collaborative efforts for CSR activities, lack of transparency in CSR initiatives, etc. She stressed on the need to align the CSR strategy with UN Sustainable Practices to achieve the SDGs by 2030.

**The first session of Day 4 on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 started with deliberations by Prof. (Dr.) Anuj Kumar Vaksha, Professor, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Dwarka on the Topic: Law And Digital Technologies: Piracy And Cyber Spaces.** He started his session by extensively explaining the importance of Piracy and Cyber Space with its 3 key ingredients: Law, Piracy/Counterfeit and Digital Technologies and Cyber Spaces. Prof. Vaksha extensively discussed the difference between Piracy and Counterfeiting in relation to Intellectual Property Rights in which piracy is an unauthorised copying, use, reproduction, distribution of materials protected whereas counterfeiting is the manufacture, importation, distribution and sale of goods which falsely carry the trademark of a genuine brand without permission and for gain or loss to another. He further demonstrated the remedies for the infringement of copyright which are given under Sections 55, 58 and 62 covering Civil remedies and Sections 63, 63 B, 65, 65 A, 65 B, 67, 68, 69 covering Criminal Remedies. The speaker also urged the audience to read the offences very carefully so that there shall not be any infringement of rights of others.

The second session of Day 4 was taken by : Mr. Arun Kumar, General Manager – HR & EMS, Caesalpin Private Limited, Delhi, who shared his experiential knowledge on the Topic: Sustainable Development through Green Technology. Mr. Arun started the session by extensively explaining the importance of green technology which is a system that uses innovative methods to create environmental friendly products. He further apprised the gathering about the goals of Green Technology – the five R's- Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose and Recycle .He extensively discussed the Green Chemistry coined by Paul Anastas in 1991 and he also called this as sustainable chemistry. He further apprised the Supercritical carbon dioxide which is used to remove organichloride pesticides from agricultural crops without adulterating the desired constituents from the plant matter in the herbal supplement industry. He further explained the concept of Geo thermal Energy .Green IT starts with manufacturers producing environmentally friendly products and encouraging IT departments to consider more friendly options like virtualization, power management and proper recycling habits. He further demonstrated the use of Green Technology in construction of buildings and showed the examples of famous green buildings of the World like Bahrain World Trade Centre, Manama, Skyscraper farming, National Library, Singapore, Residence Antilia, Mumbai and India Tower, Mumbai.

**The first session on Day 5 was taken by Prof.(Dr.) Zahir uddin Arif, Professor & Former Chairman, Deptt. Of Marketing, Faculty of Business studies, Jagannath University, Bangladesh on the topic, “ Case Study Development & writing in Management Discipline”.**

He started his session with discussion on different types of cases and their relevance in education and research . He shared the top tips for writing a case study including collecting information from primary & secondary sources, structure the narrative, identify & develop the protagonist(i.e main character/ hero), get permission, be clear about your teaching objective , identify the case lead author if writing along with your colleague, He very immaculately differentiated between Teaching cases and research focussed cases and then proceeded to share the step by step guide to writing an effective case study. He guided about various international journals where the case studies can be published

and also encouraged the participants to write case studies focussing on research and participate in case writing competitions.

The second session had Prof. Vikas Rao Vadi, Director, Don Bosco Institute of Technology , Okhla sharing his insights on the topic, " Over view of Cyber Security in Intelligent & Sustainable Manufacturing".


Professor Rao initiated his address with a brief about the importance of Cyber Security. He also explained the concept of risks caused by poor security knowledge and practice.

He explained that Cyber security refers to the body of technologies, processes, and practices designed to protect networks, devices, programs, and data from attack, damage, or unauthorized. He also laid emphasis on Secure System and its CIA Triad. He shared about how we can protect our and our stakeholder's information from getting breached.


Later he explained about various types of threats like phishing, spear, social engineering scams, malware and ransom ware. He also discussed virus and its infections like direct infection, fast infection, slow infection etc.

He concluded his discussion with the Global Cyber Security Trends – The next wave and its 3 major findings such as Growing threat to national security, Increasing threat to online services , and Emergence of a sophisticated market for software flaws and Sustainable Manufacturing in Industry 4.0.


