4.1.1 The Institution has adequate facilities for teaching- learning. viz., classrooms, laboratories, computing equipment etc. (5)

The institute's convenient location in East Delhi, well-served by metro rail, adds to its ease of access. The modern architectural elements showcased in the vast and well-planned campus building provide an environment that is ideal for students.

- a. Infrastructure-related university regulations are appropriately met.
- b. The Indian Bar Council's infrastructure standards are adhered to. For an efficient classroom exchange, the institute does, however, also have additional teaching and learning resources available.

The institute has the following infrastructural facilities:

- 1. Class room: The institute has 21 classrooms with LAN and WiFi access.
- 2. ICT lab: In addition to 72 PCs connected to LAN and Wi-Fi networks, the computer lab is equipped with an LCD projector, a projection screen, CCTV cameras, and a variety of necessary software programs. With the use of resources like a soundbar, computers, printers, scanners, and photocopiers, students can work independently. The campus also has widely available Wi-Fi and a state-of-the-art IT infrastructure with cutting-edge communication and computing resources, all of which enhance the environment for teaching and learning.

3. Library:

IIMT has 03 libraries one for law ,one for management and one for Digital Library. There are 25,477 books and 03 rare book i.e. "The Constitution of India-1950" "Speeches of President Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed" and "Jawaharlal Nehru Speeches, Vol. 03, 1953-1957".

Digital Library store and provide access to electronic resources such as e-books, e-journals

(DELNET) .Institute has subscribed national and international online journals and we can also access approx. 250 national and international online journals through DELNET. The students are also benefited with the online journal access facility indianjournal.com, publishingindia.com, sagepub.com, stm journals, American Journal of comparative Law, Supreme Court Cases, Supreme Court Reports by Digiscr. Institute has subscribed 36 national and 12 international journals and students can access approx. 250 national and international online journals through DELNET membership. In periodicals we have, 09 Magazines, 10 Daily Newspapers which are regularly subscribed for enrichment of the knowledge of faculty members as well as students. The institute also holds the membership of British Council Library, American Center Library.

a. Moot Court: A Through simulated trials on legal issues, the well-equipped Moot Court provides essential training for law students with the goal of enhancing their professional capacities and argumentation skill. Students can investigate, debate, and discuss hypothetical cases on this platform, which provides an almost real-life experience of a courtroom setting. Their ability to advocate is much improved by this immersive atmosphere, which also promotes the overall growth of their legal expertise.

Conference hall and auditorium: A well-equipped conference hall with air conditioning, a projector and smart board, a state-of-the-art sound system, CCTV, and room for more than sixty people is available on campus. A mini auditorium and a big auditorium are two of the institute's other unique spaces. Attractive and well-equipped, the compact auditorium can accommodate up to 100 pupils with its LCD projector, smart board, audio system, and CCTV surveillance. On the other hand, the main auditorium stands out for having full air conditioning, elegant furniture, and a complete setup that includes two LCD projectors in addition to two Projection screens, a state-of-the-art audio system, CCTV cameras, and microphones, all of which can fit over 400 students.

- a. The institute is equipped with an elevator and a ramp to meet the needs of students with disabilities.
- b. During their end-term exams, the institute provides visually impaired and disabled students with support and assistance.

Sports: The person in charge manages sports, mentors students, prepares the field, provides equipment, and ensures success with robust indoor and outdoor facilities.

Canteen: There is a conveniently available cafeteria nearby. People can easily enjoy meals and refreshments at this cafeteria because to its variety of dining alternatives. It provides a warm environment for employees and students to congregate, mingle, and have a snack. Because of its close proximity, the institution's facilities are more conveniently accessible overall.

Staff Room: The establishment is pleased to have three staff rooms on its premises. Of these, the management department has two set aside for its use, offering a specific area for meetings and

administrative work. In addition, the law department has its own dedicated staff area, which creates a comfortable atmosphere for attorneys to cooperate and do their duties effectively. Because both departments will have access to their own designated places thanks to this arrangement, staff members will be more productive and able to communicate effectively.

Infrastructure Facilities: Our institution's infrastructure includes a variety of well-equipped spaces that meet the various needs of our employees and students. We have 21 classrooms in total, all of which offer the perfect setting for studying. We also have two Principal's Rooms, a Management Room, a Director's Room, and a Moot Court, all of which support the academic and administrative operations of the school. The entire infrastructure is further improved by the Vice Principal's office, Incharge Office, IQAC Room, Administrative Office, Guard Room, Reading Rooms, Sports Room, Gymnasium, and Medical Room. We provide three spaces for meetings and events: the Main Auditorium can hold 400 people, the Mini Auditorium can hold 100 people, and the Conference Hall can hold 60 people. Our organization also has a fully functional kitchen, three staff rooms, a placement cell, two computer labs, two libraries, and a legal aid cell. We have a Canteen to meet the food needs of our students and staff, and two Common Rooms, one for boys and one for girls, are available for relaxing and socialization. Together, these resources offer our university a welcoming and stimulating atmosphere for recreational and academic pursuits.

Utilities facility: Our college offers an extensive range of amenities that improve campus safety and overall satisfaction. In addition to two ramps intended for accessibility, we have two elevators (lifts) to make moving between levels simple. This means that everyone, even those with impairments, may easily travel the campus. We provide seven water coolers for the convenience of both students and guests, six of which are thoughtfully positioned on each floor and one of which is outside the institution.

Two generators are located on our site to ensure a steady supply of electricity. As part of our commitment to safety, we have installed a comprehensive fire safety system that includes smoke detectors, automatic sprinklers, fire extinguishers, fire doors, first aid hose reels, house boxes with branch and hose pipes, and a dedicated ground floor pump room with overhead and fire pumps. Throughout the campus, there are forty fire safety devices in all.

We have 52 CCTV cameras placed throughout the campus for monitoring and safety reasons because security is of the utmost importance. To further ensure the comfort of all residents, our campus has 63 air conditioning units.

The underground and overhead water storage tanks, which have capacity of 70,000 and 10,000 liters, respectively, are well-maintained. In addition, we supply one photostat machine, five refrigerators, and five microwaves to meet the needs of the institution. All of these utilities work together to give our staff and students a secure, cozy, and well-equipped environment.
