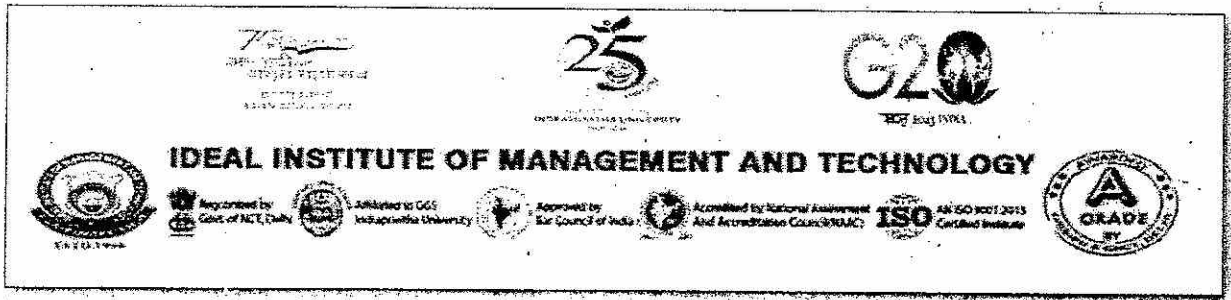

STUDENTS GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE REPORT 2023-2024


During 2023-24, The Grievances Redressal Committee received 2 formal complaints regarding student's misconduct and disciplinary action was taken against them.

The Committee under the Chairmanship of Prof. (Dr.) Anil Parkash Sharma, Director Cum Psychologist, along with Other Committee Members investigated the matter in both the instances and students were given due chance to represent themselves.


First Complaint was received on 17th February 2024, when one of the students Mr Yash Tomar of BALLB 1st Year misbehaved with the Sports Officer, Dr. Jitender Yadav during the annual Sports Meet of the college. Grievance Redressal Committee meeting for the matter was convened on 21st February, 2024 and after due deliberations a suspension order was released on the same day, debarring him from participating in any co-curricular activities or from representing the college in any external activities. The student was advised not to violate institution's code of conduct as it would result in more severe disciplinary action.

Second complaint was received on 26th February, 2024 regarding 20 students of BCA 2nd semester for disobeying the rules, casual & negligent attitude, indiscipline and disrespect to faculty members. As a disciplinary action the students were suspended for a period of 7 days. The students submitted a written apology for misconduct and the suspension was revoked on 29th February, 2024.

The committee aims to foster a positive learning environment, contributing to overall well being of students, upholding principles and transparency for a thriving educational community.

During 2022-23, The Grievances redressal Committee received 2 formal complaints regarding student's fights related to Verbal Altercations and Physical encounter .

The Committee under the Chairmanship of Prof.(Dr.) Anil Parkash Sharma , Director Cum Psychologist, along with Other Committee Members investigated the matter gathering perspectives of students involved

First Complaint recieved on 16th Nov 2022,Grievance Redressal Committee meeting for the matter was convened on 26th November, 2022, Chairman along with Ms.Shailja Khosla, Dr.Parminder Kaur , Mr. Jasdeep singh, Mr.Eesh Singh conducted a session with 6 students from BBA second shift and BA.LLB who were found involved in altercation and students found guilty were suspended , reaffirming that such event will not be repeated in future

Second complaint received on 23rd February, 2023 . Meeting for the same was conveyed on 25th February, 2023, chaired by Prof. (Dr.) Anil Parkash Sharma, Director-cum-Psychologist, IIMT along with other key members, including Dr. Vineeta Sharma, Dr. Seema Nath Jain, Dr. Arun Gupta, and Dr. Mahesh Sharma, representing different departments.The committee addressed written complaints and counter-complaints from 8 Students from BBA First and second shift, and B.A. LLB .

The committee facilitated separate and joint sessions with the complainants, allowing each student to voice their grievances. Throughout the proceedings, an amicable resolution was achieved, with all complainant students settling their disputes to mutual satisfaction.

Importantly, apologies were extended voluntarily, without external pressure or coercion under both the Grievances received. The students also expressed goodwill by extending friendly gestures towards each other, pledging not to engage in future conflicts.

The committee aim to foster poster positive learning Environment, contributing overall well being of students, upholding principles and transparency for a thriving educational Community.
