The convening team organized the event for the B.A. LL.B students spread across the years participated in the competition in various roles including Advocates, Researchers, Investigating Officer, Witnesses, Accused, Court Masters, Volunteers and Student Coordinators. The law faculty members having exposure to the criminal court practice adjudged the Preliminary Rounds and Semi-Final Rounds. The finals were adjudged by Prof. (Dr.) Arun Gupta, Principal, School of Law, Prof. (Dr.) Hemlata Sharma, Vice-Principal, School of law alongside Convener of the Competition Mr. Eesh Singh.

Brief Description of Activity:

The event was incepted with the Inaugural Session held on 12th May' 2023 wherein the participating 42 participants across 14 teams were oriented alongside the witness and investigating officer. The Principal, School of Law was the guest of honor of the session and the draw of lots as well as the exchange of memorial was carried out by the participating teams.

The Preliminary Rounds which was held on 15th May'2023 which were divided into two slots so that the participating teams can represent from both the prosecution and defense side for the Pre-Trial stage framing of the charges they also cross examined the Investigating Officer for their case. The top scoring 4 teams were qualified for the semi-final rounds. The draws of lots for the semi-final rounds as well as the memorials were exchanged the same day.

The following day, the four teams competed against each other in a knock out Semi Final Round wherein the trial proceedings were held. The students argued and presented their case with enthusiasm and cross examined the Investigating Officer and witnesses for their respective cases.

The winners of the semi final round further presented their case in the final round wherein the round was adjudged by Prof. (Dr.) Arun Gupta, Principal, School of Law, Prof. (Dr.) Hemlata Sharma, Vice-Principal, School of law alongside Convener of the Competition Mr. Eesh Singh.

The competition was concluded with the Valedictory Ceremony in which the chairs were felicitated and the winners were appreciated with the certificates and memento. The participating teams, IO, witnesses, accused and volunteers were also presented with their certificates.

Overall the competition was a great success and met its objective of providing clinical education of criminal trial proceedings.

As per the feedback received, it was a fruitful, informative and learning experience for the first year students and it was ended on the happy note.



"Relevance of Lower Judiciary in Constitutionalism"

On 1st November, 2019

The Ideal Training & Placement Cell of Ideal Institute of Management and Technology, affiliated to GGSIPU organized a Seminar under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell on "Relevance of Lower Judiciary in Constitutionalism" was held on 1st November, 2019 for 4th and 5th year BA.LL.B students at IIMT. Speaker of the day was Mr. Pruthvi Raj N.K., Founder Director, Pruthvi Law Classes.

The aim for this Seminar was to enrich the students about the Relevance of Lower Judiciary in Constitutionalism. The organizing team of the Seminar was comprised of Dr. Arun Gupta, Vice Principal, Dr. Hemlata Sharma, Associate Professor, Mr. Jasdeep Singh, Assistant Professor. The Seminar was for two hours which was attended by 104 students. The response received from the students was overwhelming and affirmative.

The session began with the Felicitation of the speaker Mr. Pruthvi Raj N.K. by Prof. (Dr.) T.P.S Rathore, Principal School of Law, IIMT. Speaking on the occasion Mr. Prithvi, told about the relevance of lower Judiciary in constitutionalism. He enlightened with statistics and knowledge

of the role plays by Judiciary in implementation of Constitution. Constitutionalism refers to when we put and implement Constitution in our day-to-day lives. He gave example that when we exercise our right to speech and expression under Article 19(1)(a) we have certain restrictions as well, we may speak anything but we cannot record anything which may lead to sedition or any outrage in the country.

Comparing the judiciary and law firms as a career, he defined that the law firms restrict to a certain field. For example if a person deals with mergers and acquisition then he won't be able to deal with criminal law as effectively as a litigating lawyer would be able to do. He stated that it's the best part of law to pursue litigation at least few years of your life because litigating lawyer is one who never retires.

While describing the role of Judge, he told that it is not necessary that from the first day they are exposed to all the laws even he or she may be topper. There may be a possibility that for one to two years only deal with Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act. Being a Judge provides us with exposure to law, further it's a assured government job, hence it provides the security one needs for the future.

One attempt Principle. This principle was laid down by Mr. Prithvi which means that one should give attempt to judiciary only once and it's not worth to second attempt. This is because the seniority decreases day by day and it won't be sensible to wait for years preparing for judiciary. Comparing the preparation of judiciary with civil services he further told us that in judicial exams they only test the bare act language, however in civil services exam they test from history to current affairs which might not be more appealing to many students.

It was ended up to be a brainstorming session. Students were made aware about the Relevance of Lower Judiciary in Constitutionalism. The students learnt about the difference of working in law firms, litigation and Judiciary.






