The issues pertaining to cultivation, manufacture, distribution, and sale of substances which are subject to drug prohibition laws were discussed at length. The Declaration on the Rule of Law, Member States of United Nations (UN) having time and again acknowledged the importance of strengthened international cooperation in countering the global drug problematic situation was acknowledged by many of the representative participants. laying forth the cross-border approach to tackle identified drug crime areas through global coordination, in contrast to bilateral arrangements or a decentralized, case-by-case approach to curb the global menace. (February 26, 2020)

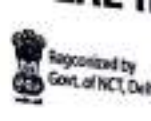
